AMENDED ORDER REGARDING PLACE OF FILING PETITIONS

THE COURT having considered that the United States Courthouse in Gulfport, Mississippi, has been closed because of damages sustained from Hurricane Katrina and that Rule 5, Uniform Local Bankruptcy Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court in the Northern and Southern Districts of Mississippi, which governs the place of filing a petition commencing a case under Title 11, United States Code, must of necessity be suspended until further notice:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that petitions commencing a case in the Southern District of Mississippi for the Southern, Hattiesburg and Eastern Divisions, under Title 11, United States Code, shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court in Hattiesburg, Mississippi.
