The Mississippi Bar's Prosecutors Section presents "Mississippi Rules of Criminal Procedure." Former Justice Ann Hannaford Lamar led the committee to form Mississippi's first comprehensive set of criminal rules. Prior to her retirement in 2016, the Mississippi Supreme Court unanimously adopted the Mississippi Rules of Criminal Procedure. The new rules took effect July 1, 2017. This CLE will be an informative presentation of the thought process and planning behind the development of the rules, and Justice Lamar will highlight some of the major changes that the rules will have in the practice of criminal law. She will be joined in the presentation by Justice Robert P. Chamberlin, who currently serves on the criminal rules committee at the Supreme Court. Justice Chamberlin was elected to the Court following Justice Lamar's retirement.
